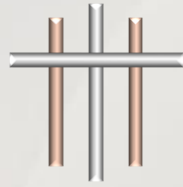

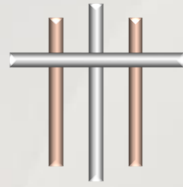

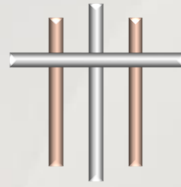

Dear Friends and HopeSiders,

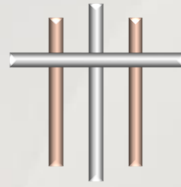

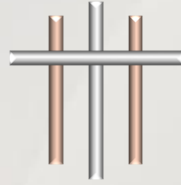
Hello Bro. Andy,

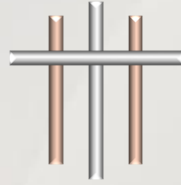

History

The HopeSide Story

2009

Anand K. Chavakula had an idea or vision about a unique approach to expanding outreach through an all-in-one highly integrated online portal that would be called HOPESIDE. This idea came as a response to better enable the church to be highly focused and equipped to expand outreach in a simplified manner. Current outreach approaches are all good in their own ways but it is a fragmented approach and one hand does not know what the other maybe doing. This can result in many inefficiencies and easily sidetrack the church from its main mission. On January 1, 2009, the word HopeSide.Org was registered as an Internet domain to facilitate the development of his outreach vision.

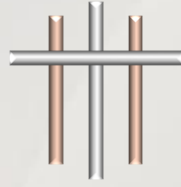
Anand was invited by his friends Samuel Kaligithi and Richard Ganta to help with starting an evening worship on Saturdays at Calverton Baptist Church. Anand said that he would help with music and other development if the HopeSide model of outreach was attempted as part of the evening worship. All agreed to gradually implement this plan. To develop this project, an investment was made by Anand to buy a wide variety of Audio Visual equipment in late 2010.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, and hurdles that came along the way, the evening worship project was stalled and the group was disbanded.

Previously, a Telugu group (Telugu is a language spoken in the State of Andhra Pradesh in India) was meeting on Saturday mornings for Sabbath services in this same location. This group also ended their morning services in late 2010 after many years of meeting at the Calverton Baptist Church.

Though highly disappointed, Anand pursued to get the church that sponsored the Telugu group to consider sponsoring the HopeSide outreach project as a Branch Sabbath School as a first step.

While pursuing an Adventist church sponsorship, HopeSide Ministries, Inc. was created to help launch HopeSide Community Church and to facilitate other projects under the "HopeSide" name. HopeSide Ministries, Inc. is now a tax exempt organization.



History

The HopeSide Story

2011

Takoma Park SDA Church voted to sponsor HopeSide as a branch Sabbath school in early 2011. After many other issues had to be overcome, access to the current Church facility was finally obtained in June of 2011.

During the early part of 2011, Steven D. Rollakanti came to know about Anand's project and came forward to support financially to help launch HopeSide. His help has been invaluable in getting HopeSide started. Anand decided that an evening worship group meeting would not succeed as much as a morning church style meeting. But there were no supporters at this time to facilitate a morning worship.

Word was spread and announcements were made in various avenues like Pr. Charles Tidwell's newsletters and through Craigslist.com to invite anyone to come and help build the outreach model of HopeSide.

Supporters who had an intense desire to engage in outreach through innovative means came forward to help launch the HopeSide vision through the establishment of the HopeSide Community Church. The reason it is called a "Community Church" is to inspire those who come give it the respect and commitment it deserves as the meaning of a church is that it is simply a "meeting of the Lord" or "about the Lord." This meaning is derived from the Greek word "Kyrios" which means "of the Lord." It is also community oriented in that anyone no matter their background can come freely and take active part in worship and outreach. We believe that as people engage in serving God and others, they will be changed. HopeSide exists therefore to be a sanctuary or a refuge for anyone to come and find healing and wholeness in Jesus.

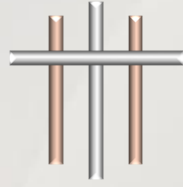
September 3, 2011

September 1, 2012

The HopeSide Community Church has applied to be a mission group of the Allegheny East Conference and an action was taken to accept us as a mission group. A formal ceremony will take place later in September after some additional formalities are completed. Many thanks to the AEC leadership and Dr. Marcus Harris who is the area District leader for working to make this happen.



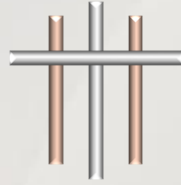
Mission

To The HopeSide Community Fellowship,

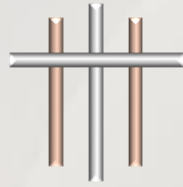
